

Miquette McMahon grew up in Haiti facing hardship and limited opportunities until she received a life-changing opportunity through Rotary International's Youth Exchange Program in 2000 to study in Minnesota. Despite knowing little English, she persevered, later returning to the United States to complete high school and earn a Bachelor of Arts in Nursing, becoming the first in her family to graduate from high school or college. In 2007, she founded Teach Haiti, a nonprofit providing Christ-centered education, which now serves over 650 students across two campuses and employs more than 130 staff members. Recognized with multiple awards and named one of the Top 50 Most Inspiring Women in Haiti in 2024, Miquette continues to share her story of faith and resilience while raising her three children with her husband in Ohio.

Michael Angelo Caruso teaches presentation skills on six continents. He's worked with Hallmark, Bank of America, Verizon, Rayovac, Citgo, and Nissan.
